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## What is the Kura Waka Leadership Intensive Programme?

**Kurawaka** is an intensive leadership programme for Māori Nurses and Midwives who have completed the Ngā Manukura o Āpōpō Foundation Programme. It draws on the potential for life and growth within the fertile soils of Kurawaka, following a journey of development that builds from the rich platform of the Foundation Leadership Programme.

The 10 month programme will involve a blend of wānanga; workshops and group work that will be co-created with participants. All participants will be required to develop an individual professional development plan and personal leadership objectives for the programme.

The programme will require about 8 days of your time for scheduled activity and events - so your whānau and employer will need to approve release time for you to attend. Some activities and hui will be via Zoom - so you will need to have access to (and know how to use) these platforms and other social media.

Marae in Otautahi, Pōneke and Tāmaki Makaurau will be the venues for delivery of the programme with these costs covered by the programme. There is some funding available for travel assistance, however there is no funding for release time. Note: some funding for locum cover for LMC's may be available.
